After anchoring, take a break to snorkel with sea lions or explore the island's hidden coves. The day wraps up with a beachside BBQ under the stars, where we'll debrief and discuss tomorrow's plan.

Day 3: Monday: Partida & Anchoring Techniques

Evening discussions will cover the day's lessons and prepare you for sail trim training.
